## Edgewood

Located at 3008 Warminster Road near Warminster, Virginia on the southeast side of Route 626, 1.4 miles northeast of the intersection with Route 743.

<a href="#">Joseph Carrington Cabell</a>	Dec. 28, 1778 - Feb. 5, 1856	Son of Nicholas & Hannah Cabell
<a href="#">Mary Walker Carter Cabell</a> *	1788 - 1862	Wife of Joseph C. Cabell. Daughter of George & Lelia Carter
<a href="#">R. Parke F. Carter</a>	? – Oct. 11, 1839	Daughter of Dr. Charles Carter. Niece of Mary Walker Carter Cabell
<a href="#">Margaret Logan Cabell Self</a>	Feb. 12, 1902 - 1996	Daughter of Margaret Polk Logan & Joseph Hartwell Cabell
<a href="#">Sydney Baldwin Self</a>	1896 - 1980	Husband of Margaret Logan Cabell Self
<a href="#">George Selden Somerville</a>	Jan. 4, 1896 – Sept. 15, 1973	2 <sup>nd</sup> husband of Mary Groesbeck Cabell Somerville (descendant of Col. William Cabell, Sr.)
<a href="#">Mary Groesbeck Cabell Somerville</a>	July 23, 1911 – Sept. 15, 1998	Daughter of Louise Telford Groesbeck & Joseph Hartwell Cabell (descendant of Nicholas Cabell)
<a href="#">Lelia Skipwith Tucker</a>	? – Sept. 30, 1837	Mother of Mary Walker Carter Cabell. 1 <sup>st</sup> husband was George Carter, 2 <sup>nd</sup> husband was Judge Saint George Tucker
<a href="#">Judge Saint George Tucker</a> *	July 10, 1752 – Nov. 10, 1827	Stepfather of Mary Walker Carter Cabell

\* NOTE: Judge Tucker's grave stone notes he died in 1828 but his wife's prayer book lists the date of death as 1827 (Moore). Mary Walker Carter Cabell died sometime between December 21, 1861 and January 27, 1862 (date her will was probated), not in 1863 as Alexander Brown states. (Moore)
