

# EARLY CABELL FAMILY GRAVEYARDS

## Traveller's Rest

Located one mile south of Warminster and across the James River in Buckingham County, Virginia on Route 604.

There are two graveyards on the property – the original and a new one close to the house. The older graveyard was restored by a member of the Cabell Family Society.
