

EARLY CABELL FAMILY GRAVEYARDS

Zion Hill/Yellow Gravel

Zion Hill (also Sion Hill) was located in Buckingham County between Warminster and Wingna on the Buckingham side of James River.

Joseph Cabell and his wife, Mary Hopkins (1735-1811) were buried at Zion Hill but the stones and remains were relocated by Robert Harvey Cabell (1869-1947) of Ridgewood, NJ. Unfortunately, there is no record as to where he moved them or why.

Joseph Cabell, Jr. (1762-1831) may have been buried here and moved in 1946 to Oakwood Cemetery in Charlottesville, VA. (See Montevideo/Repton).
